Family responsibilities We agree to:-

• Ensure our child attends school regularly, on time and "ready to learn". Children can come into school from 8.50am to 9am.(Before 8.50am please book into Breakfast Club)

• Telephone school on the first day of our child's absence. Let the school know about any concerns, problems or changes in our family circumstances that may affect our child's work or behaviour.

• Respect, support and uphold the school's policies and rules, including behaviour and anti-bullying policies.

- Support our child reading and (from Y1) times tables practise every day at home and also with their homework .
- Attend parents' consultations about our child's progress and effort.
- Ensure that our child wears the correct school uniform and school PE/Games kit .
- Ensure that all clothing and property is marked with our child's name.

• Uphold the ethos of the School's Healthy Eating Policy and reflect this in our child's packed lunch where appropriate.
