Fun with Maths: Attached is a flyer and letter about a Maths workshop to be held in the TreeHouse for the parents/carers/grandparents of children in Reception and Year 1. The two sessions provide an opportunity for parents/carers and grandparents to learn how your child is taught Maths and early number skills in Reception and Year 1. A hard-copy of the parental response form will be sent out to children on Monday.

Home Time Routines - The safety of our pupils is our top priority. At 3:15pm we have nearly 90 children attempting to leave school out of one door and this is causing major congestion issues at the bottom of the stairs. To help find a solution Y3/4 will now exit from their cloakroom door where staff will call their name when their parent/family member can be seen. For Y1/2, the children are asked to tell staff when they can see the adult who is collecting them. If there is no one to collect them the children must wait with an adult in school.

If you are delayed for any reason please inform the school office as soon as possible. We appreciate that there are some occasions when alternative arrangements are made. In these circumstances we need to be informed of the end of day arrangements via email, in writing or a telephone call in advance. It is

extremely important that we are informed of any alternative arrangements you may make e.g. parents who make arrangements with other parents to take their child/children home (this may be on a regular basis, every now and again or a contingency plan).

We apologise for any inconvenience caused to parents prior to this message being sent and we hope we can work together in order to ensure the safety of our pupils at all times. Thank you for your continued support.

Parents Evening: Yesterday, you will have received a letter regarding your child/children's Parents Evening. Please complete the return slip so that your child's teacher can arrange a convenient appointment for you. **Please note that Reception and Nursery appointments are only for Thursday 8th February.**

Parent Council: Thank you to all of who attended the last meeting. The discussions that take part are of a real benefit to a shared vision for school improvement. If you were unable to attend but would like to discuss school improvement please see Miss Redmayne who can point you in the right direction or see Lisa Horrocks – a parent in Y6. Many thanks.

Parental help questionnaires: All staff have been provided with information regarding families and parents offering to help in school. Thank you all so much for donating your time – we look forward to utilising all your skills as much as we can!

Parent Pay: Please can you ensure that all Parent Pay accounts are up-to-date.

Open-Door Policy: At Rivington we are proud to operate an Open Door Policy. The purpose of our Open Door Policy is to encourage open communication, feedback and discussion. We value the input parents make to the school. Class teachers will usually be available for an Open Door meeting at the end of the school day, during handover. Can we kindly request that parents avoid coming into the building until after the children have left after 3:30pm. In some cases, the teacher may not be available for genuine reasons and a different meeting time should be arranged. If you feel that the matter needs more than 10 minutes to discuss, then parents should phone the school office to make an appointment to see the member of staff at a mutually convenient time. Staff may also be available to take phone calls, when they are not available please leave a contact number so that the member of staff may call you back at a different time.

In the spirit of our Open Door Policy, the Parents Council meets termly to discuss new initiatives, issues/policies and events.

Thank you so much for your continued co-operation.

Dropping Off and Picking Up From School –In the interest of the safety of the children and all pedestrians, please avoid parking on the zig-zag lines or near the

terrible bend or on the pavement in any circumstances. Thank you for your cooperation.

Reporting your child absent: If your child is unwell and won't be able to attend school, please contact school to inform us of the absence. This can be done by telephoning school and selecting option 1.

Free School Meals: All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 automatically qualify for universal free school meals. However children in the infants and the juniors may qualify for free school meals because you are in receipt of certain benefits, in which case you need to register your eligibility. If you are eligible your child could qualify for Pupil Premium funding from the Government which will come into school to improve pupil attainment or provide additional opportunities.
