Reading: One of our school improvement priorities this year is to develop reading across school and home. - 2. Breakfast Club is in the playground until 8:45am (weather permitting) if Parents could please not enter the site until this time unless attending a meeting or through absolute necessity. When entering the site can you please make sure that you close any gate behind you. Staff will be around to help support with this.

Admission Information for 2020-21: Admissions for Reception places opened on Monday 2nd September. Please apply online to LCC by January 15th 2020. Our Admissions policy is available from school and on our website. An open day and evening will be available shortly.

Secondary School Admissions: Secondary applications can be made on line and you should clearly state 3 preferences for your child. If you are applying to a church school there is a supplementary form which needs to be completed. The closing date for Secondary School Admissions is **Thursday 31st October 2019**.

Water Bottles: Children can bring sports cap water bottles into school so that they have access to a drink in class throughout the day. Please ensure that their name is on the bottle and that they only fill their bottle with natural water.

Dropping Off and Picking Up From School: The road outside of school is obviously very busy at the start and end of the day. In the interest of the safety of the children and all



pedestrians under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked on the zigzag lines. This is dangerous and could cause an accident. Thank you for your understanding.

Free School Meals: All children in Reception, Year I and Year 2 automatically qualify for Universal free school meals. However children in the infants and the juniors may qualify for free school meals because you are in receipt of certain benefits, in which case you need to register your eligibility. If you are eligible your child could qualify for Pupil Premium funding from the Government which will come into school to improve pupil attainment or provide additional opportunities. If you require further information please do not hesitate to contact the office.
