
Newsletter 3: 24.01.2020. This Terms Value is Perseverance:

BBC Radio 2 - 500 Words 2020: The UK's largest story writing competition for kids is back for its tenth year. 500 Words is the UK's most successful short story-writing competition for children between the ages of 5 and 13. Since the competition launched 934,296 stories have been entered in the competition. It was launched back in 2011, after Chris Evans had a dream. He dreamt of getting children excited about reading and writing. All children: no matter what their ability, experience, or background. 2019 attracted over 110, 000 entries children to the short story competition, and since it launched, the competition has received over 912,986 short stories. All entrants must pen an original story, no more than 500 words in length, and submit it online. It can be about ANYTHING you want – space-ships, grannies, insects, time travel. The list is endless! Fairtrade Design a Card Competition: TO CELEBRATE THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FAIRTRADE MARK. Help us mark this anniversary by designing an anniversary card. You may want to examine one particular product, such as tea or chocolate more closely, or look at a range of products. This is especially relevant in light of the Oxfam Behind the Barcodes report which highlights the poor conditions in which many of the workers who produce our food still live.
