6. At the end the rush (6,000 children + parents) will be dreadful. We will meet you at the front, main entrance of Victoria Station. You will need to pick the children up before you go and get your car (why not travel by train?) as you won't be able to pull in, even to just pick up.
7. The children will not need to take any money with them.
