
### Newsletter 8: 06.03.2020. This Terms Value is Respect:

**Updated travel advice for travellers returning from Italy:** The advice remains the same for travellers returning from the lockdown areas of Italy - that you should self-isolate even if you are not showing symptoms. The advice for other parts of Italy has been expanded to cover the whole country: if you have returned from anywhere else in Italy outside of the lockdown areas, you should self-isolate if you develop symptoms and call NHS III.
