<p>PE Play your favourite song and make up a dance routine to it.</p>	<p>Music/Expressive Arts and Deign Make a rainstick or another musical instrument.</p>	<p>RSE Feelings Keep a diary for a week and write about the things you have done and how you are feeling. You might want to add in illustrations.</p>	<p>Science/Understanding the World Create a display about the life cycle of a butterfly. Can you include pupa, chrysalis, lava and caterpillar.</p>	<p>DT/ Expressive Arts and Deign Create a picture of a superhero using collage materials (for example paper, tissue paper, straws, buttons, feathers, foil etc)</p>
<p>RE Make an Easter Garden.</p>	<p>Art/ Expressive Arts and Deign Design a chair made from newspaper/paper that will hold a stuffed teddy. Try rolling the newspaper to make the chair strong.</p>	<p>Science: Materials Find different objects around the house and write down what material or materials it is made out of. Make sure you find at least one example of each material - wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. For example: The door is made out of wood.</p>	<p>Art/ Expressive Arts and Deign Mix different coloured paints to make the colour green and then make alien handprints and/or footprints. Can you think of an alien name for them using your phonics? Eg, Gloik, plure, schray</p>	<p>RE Find out a game that Jesus would have played, learn the rules and have fun playing it. Eg Ludo, hopscotch, marbles, spinning tops.</p>
<p>PE Practise catching and throwing a ball.</p>	<p>RSE Talk to your adults about the word 'proud'. What makes you feel proud? Draw a picture of someone or something that makes you feel proud. This could be an achievement, an award or an event.</p>	<p>History/The World Find out about a significant person from the past and create a poster or fact file. Eg. Samuel Pepys Christopher Wren Charles Darwin Christopher Columbus Florence Nightingale</p>	<p>DT /Expressive Arts and Deign Choose your favourite animal and make an animal mask. Find out about where in the world they live, habitat and some interesting facts.</p>	<p>Art/Expressive Arts and Deign Research and artist and create a piece of art inspired by them e.g. Mondrian, Picasso, Kandinsky</p>
<p>Geography-The world Draw a map of your route to school. Add a key to show the buildings and places you pass along the way.</p>	<p>Computing Discuss with a family member how to stay safe online.
