Dear Parents / Carers,

On Tuesday 29th September we are pleased to welcome the M and M theatre company to school. M and M visited school at the same time last year and their productions (even in the Church Hall) are nothing short of amazing! Obviously, Covid-19 has meant that they had to adapt and change their procedures and performances.

To start with, the company normally performs to the whole-school which lasts around an hour but they will now stay all day and perform to each 'bubble'. The children will wash their hands prior to entering and on leaving the hall. The hall will be cleaned between performances (the children will sit on chairs and mats that will be sanitised between performances) and the performer will also follow strict hygiene procedures between performances including being allocated their own toilet which the children do not use.

The company normally send around 5 actors but this year there will only be one who will perform alongside a live cinematic experience (on a large screen) which the company will bring. This year's production is 'The Wizard of Oz' and it is suitable for all year groups. Attached is some information sent by the company regarding the performance. Risk assessments are available upon request.

I'm sure you will agree that this sounds like a fantastic and quality experience for our children at a time when such experiences are still limited. It will help to enhance and enrich our exciting curriculum. In order to support the funding of the activity **school is politely asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.00** towards the costs. Parents are not obliged to make a contribution and the school will try to support costs through its own budget, but this would reduce what we are able to spend in terms of materials and equipment for the children.
