## How to make a christingle



## What you will need

- An orange
- Some foil
- A candle (such as a birthday candle but not a tea light)
- Red ribbon or tape (enough to go round the orange)
- 4 cocktail sticks
- Sweets or dried fruit
- A tool to make a hole in the top of the orange with



Make a hole in the top of your orange (with scissors, a sharp pencil or your thumb)





Push your candle through the foil into the hole in the top on your orange so it's secure





Wrap a strip of red tape or ribbon around the middle of your orange and secure it





Stick the 4 cocktail sticks into the orange around the candle





Push the sweets/fruit onto the sticks (ensuring the ends are covered)





Light the candle (with the help of an adult)



## What the components mean:

- The **orange** represents the world The **candle** reminds Christians of
- The **candle** reminds Christians of Jesus, who they believe to be the light of the world
- The **red ribbon** goes around the 'world' and, being the colour of blood, reminds Christians that Jesus died
- The four cocktail sticks could have one of two meanings; the four seasons or the four corners of the world
- The sweets (or sometimes dried fruit) remind Christians of God's gifts to the world, including kindness and love
