We wanted to hold a summer fair this year but - due to being in a high infection area - are not able to invite Parents/Carers and Grandparents - sorry. We have, although, decided to hold a Covid-safe fair for the children that they are able to enjoy in their bubbles. We are attempting to combine some of the favourite elements of the fair so that the children can have an amazing time and so that we can raise further funds for the £3000 pounds we desperately want to raise in order to improve our reading provision.

This Summer Fair will take place next Friday the 18th June from 12pm-2:30pm.

We are asking the children to bring in **£5 each** and this will allow them to have at least **one (if not more)** go at every game and activity and receive an ice-pop. The games and activities available so far are listed below.
