SPARKLE DAY – MONDAY 4 JULY 2022

On Monday 4th July we are inviting the children to take part in Sparkle Day. The children can wear something sparkly (no matter how small) in return for a donation of at least a £1 to the Sparkle Bean Trust – a charity set up by the head teacher at Tarleton Community Primary – Chris Upton. I am happy to share a communication from Chris Upton in respect of this charitable organisation established following the school's tragic loss of a pupil in the Manchester terrorist attack...

'I am just making contact in regard to the planning of our Sparkle Day on Monday 4th July 2022 to see if your school can support us.

You may be aware that I released a book recently with the profits going to a charity we set up called Sparkle Bean. The charity supports schools in two ways following the sudden death of a primary aged pupil. Firstly, through sharing learning. Secondly, by providing small grants to a school for the leadership of that school to use as they see fit.

What does this look like in practice?

Sadly, today I visited a North West based school who had suffered the loss of a Y6 pupil, killed by a drink driver at Christmas time. I was able to share learning and provide a cheque for £300 which the school are spending on their Y6 Prom at the end of the school year to support their approaches to transition with this particular cohort.

We will be asking parents to take their children directly to West Way for a 9:00am start and collect from Westway at 11:30am and take your children back to school for lunch and afternoon sessions. Parents are welcome to stay and watch the events of the day and enjoy refreshments. We will be sending more information as soon as possible, following consultation with Chorley Sports Partnership who are helping us to organise the day.
