The Queen's dedication to public service has been an inspiration to children and adults alike over the past 70 years. She will be hugely missed by the nation, including all those in the world of education where many people will have fond memories of Jubilee and other royal events during her reign. Through her dignity and unswerving sense of duty the Queen has set an extraordinary example to us all, and she has been a reassuring presence through many turbulent times.

The school will enter a period of mourning for ten days. There will be very few changes to school life during this national period of mourning. However, it is right and proper for School to show leadership for the local community in such times. The staff meetings will be cancelled on Monday as a small mark of respect, and to allow for private thought. Furthermore, a book of condolence will be placed on a decorative table in the playground for any member of the school, or local community, to pay respects... which in turn will provide a source of Primary Historical Evidence as to how the local community responded. The laying of the book will be the first, and last thing we do each day until the funeral.

This week the children will have further opportunities to reflect personally and express their own thoughts, in an appropriate way.

'The official date of the State Funeral – Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September - will be a bank holiday. Schools are not expected to remain open on the bank holiday as it should be treated as any normal bank holiday.' Therefore, School will be closed on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022 in order for all to pay their respects.

**Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium** - All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 automatically qualify for Universal Free School meals. However, children in the infants and the juniors may qualify for free school meals because you are in receipt of certain benefits, in which case you need to register your eligibility. If you are eligible your child could qualify for Pupil Premium funding from the Government which will come into school to improve pupil attainment or provide additional opportunities. If you require further information, please do not hesitate to contact the office.

**PE Kits** – Please can we remind you to label all uniform and PE kits and make sure children have PE kits in school.

**Water Bottles-** Children can bring a water bottle into school so they have access to a drink in class throughout the day. Please ensure their name is on their bottle and that they only fill their bottles with natural water. Thank you for your support.
