In addition, research has proven that reading regularly improves a young person's academic potential across the full curriculum.

Consequently, we are always looking at innovative ways to engage our pupils in reading for pleasure and would like to tell you about a brilliant app called BorrowBox that allows pupils to do just that. The app, which can be downloaded onto smart phones and tablets, allows pupils to access hundreds of eBooks and eAudiobooks, free of charge.

BorrowBox requires you to have a membership with the Lancashire library services. Memberships are free and can be easily applied for online following this link:

Once you have downloaded the app onto a smart phone or tablet, you will need to log in using your library membership number and PIN. These will be sent to you by the library service and can be requested when you first try to log into the app. Books and audiobooks can be borrowed on the app for 14 days, at which point books can be renewed or returned.

You may find that, as in the normal library, some books are already on loan. These can be reserved and will become available to you once they have been returned.

For any pupils who are unsure of what to read, recommended reads can be found attached with this letter and on the school website for all year groups. In addition, you may want to look at the Books for Topics website which suggests titles for all the topics and narrative styles that we cover in school:
