

As you can see – these two items are £3.00 cheaper than current prices. I am going to access samples for the Jim Jam Jog and at pick-up on the  $26^{th}$  May for you to look at – I'm certain that you will be pleased with their quality. These two items will be available in both purple and black (Y6). Knitted options will continue to be available at the current price until stock runs out.

All other items are not increasing in price but we have accessed a better quality optional coat (which is warmer, has a stronger hood and more reflective strips) for the same price as the one we have now.

We have also asked Jada to look into options for our PE kit. Nothing has been decided yet but any proposed changes would go to consultation and have a two-year implementation period during which time all existing items can be worn. We are also looking at fundraising in order to support any improvements.

Please be assured that both the existing jumpers, cardigans and coats will be part of our school uniform going forward and for as long as you need to use them. So if you had a child in Y1 with a sibling in Y5, we would actively encourage you to use the knitwear of the older child for the younger one as they moved through school. The jumpers, cardigans and coat are not a change in uniform policy but are just an improvement in quality and cost of it.

In the statutory guidance for maintained schools, the Government have stated that:

- Parents should not have to think about the cost of a school uniform when choosing which school(s) to apply for. Therefore, schools need to ensure that their uniform is affordable.
- In considering cost, schools will need to think about the total cost of school uniforms, taking
  into account all items of uniform or clothing parents will need to provide while their child is at
  the school.
- Schools should keep the use of branded items to a minimum.

- A school's uniform policy should be published on the school's website, be available for all parents, including parents of prospective pupils, and be easily understood.
- Schools should ensure that their uniform supplier arrangements give the highest priority to cost and value for money (including the quality and durability of the garment).
- Single supplier contracts should be avoided unless regular tendering competitions are run where more than one supplier can compete for the contract and where the best value for money is secured. This contract should be retendered at least every 5 years.
- Schools should ensure that second-hand uniforms are available for parents to acquire.
   Information on second-hand uniforms should be clear for parents of current and prospective pupils and published on the school's website.
- Schools should engage with parents and pupils when they are developing their school uniform policy.

Below are a few suggestions which could be looked at when we are reconsidering our current policy – it does not mean that these suggestions will be placed into policy:

EXAMPLES THAT COULD BE CHANGED:	REASONS WHY THIS MIGHT BE A GOOD DECISION
Pupils will no longer need to wear branded skirts and pinafores. Instead, they can wear a plain grey one	This will reduce the cost of our uniform.  This may make uniform more cost effective for groups – for example girls over boys and supports religious
We provide a sew-on or iron-on badge that can be placed onto plain purple unbranded jumpers and cardigans.	This will reduce the cost of our uniform.  This will mean that families can access non-branded jumpers.
