Medicines in School - If medicine needs to be taken under exceptional circumstances, then we are happy to administer this if there has been a written agreement made with parents and the appropriate form from the office completed. This is primarily for prescribed medication. However, again in exceptional circumstances and following the previously mentioned procedures, we will also give Calpol, etc. if there is a real need. Please note that this is not routine. In order to administer this we require that it

is
provided in the form of a sealed
sachet that has the exact amount
in and is labelled with the child's
name by the chemist. These are
readily available from chemists.

Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium - All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 automatically qualify for Universal Free School meals, but may also qualify for free school meals if their parents are in receipt of certain benefits. This is also the case for children in the juniors. If this is the case you will need to register your eligibility. If you are eligible your child could qualify for Pupil Premium funding from the Government which will come into school to improve pupil attainment or provide additional opportunities. A quick check can be carried out by LCC. All we need is your national insurance number and date of birth and we can send your information to be checked. If you need any further information please contact the school office.

NUT ALLERGIES - Please could you also ensure that your child does not bring any food into school that CONTAINS NUTS as we do have a children with nut allergies in school. Thank you for your cooperation.

Fruit Only Snacks & Toast - As we are a healthy school, and we are educating and promoting healthy lifestyles to our children, fruit and vegetable only snacks are allowed for break times. Toast will also be available at 20p per slice on Fridays.

In the interest of the safety of the children and all pedestrians, please, under no circumstances, park on the zig zag lines or the pavement. I appeal to all parents to show consideration to our neighbours by avoiding blocking their drives or business entrance.

Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring the safety of you children.

First Aid The vast majority of our staff are first aid trained and we have members of staff assigned outside to first aid at breaktimes and lunch. This means that instead of coming straight to the office the children are looked at straight away and basic first aid may be administered, eg. cleaning a graze, putting a plaster on, etc. All the staff do a fantastic job if the children are sent in to be looked at. Accident forms are sent home if we feel necessary, and always following a bumped head, but may not be completed if the injury is deemed very minor and has caused your child no distress. In addition, we ask children who have had a bump to the head to wear a band on their arm in order to ensure that all adults are aware of the incident and keep an eye on them.
