In a School Year, If Your Child is Late Every Day By	Your Child Would Have Lost Approximately	or They Would Have Missed Approximately
5 Minutes	3.5 Days from School	20 Lessons
10 Minutes	7 Days from School	41 Lessons
15 Minutes	10 Days from School	55 Lessons
20 Minutes	14.5 Days from School	82 Lessons
30 Minutes	22 Days from School	123 Lessons

Thank you for making contact when your child is absent.

- Please do so as early as possible on the day of absence. You can call or email <u>bursar@rivington.lancs.sch.uk</u>
- If they are absent for more than one day please make daily contact unless advised not to.
- Please understand that even authorised absence for illness/appointments will affect your child's attendance percentage.
 However, we will not take any issue with authorised absence.
- If your child is going to be late, give us a call or send us a message. Please make sure you come to sign your child in at the office.

Top tips to avoid lateness!

- Make it a race or competition to be ready first.
 Set up a sticker chart with a reward at the end of the week for being on time every day.
- ◆ Schedule quality time with you once they are ready 10 minutes before you need to go.
- ♦ Aim to get here 10 minutes before you need to arrive.
- ♦ Get everything ready laid out the night before together.
