## **School Dinners**

I wanted to inform you that we have made the decision to move school lunches back into school instead of using the Church Hall. This was something that was done in this way at Rivington for a long time and during our Covid days so we are confident that we will all adjust very quickly. Renting the hall is becoming increasingly more costly and reducing our use of it to when needed for PE or assemblies will save school a substantial amount of money. I'm sure you will agree that allocating money to support the direct progress of our children - particularly with such challenging school budgets - is a better choice.

For the short-term, we have made minor changes to the menu that means that the children will more or less be given the same options as previously with some minor adjustments. The new menu will be available to you as we return and choices are to be made online in the usual way.

In the longer term, we are proactively looking to install a small kitchen back in Y1/2. We are also looking at options regarding having our own school hall built.
